Exhibition containers provided for cut flowers only. Floral design exhibitors to provide own containers, stands, etc. All exhibits to be grown by the exhibitor except floral design. All cut flowers to become the property of the Society.

Horticulture Display Times

Saturday: Open (when judging is completed) approx. 10am until 9pm

Sunday: Open 9:00am until 4:00pm

Exhibits may be collected between 4pm and 5pm on Sunday. The doors will be closed whilst exhibitors are collecting their exhibits.

First and Second prize cards to be awarded, where standard of exhibit warrants such awards.

A Special Prize will be awarded by the Society to the exhibitor, not being a nursery person, who is the most successful in the Horticulture Section of the Show.

Entry fee in all classes \$2.00. One gate pass for an exhibitor that has 5 or more entries.
